

WHAT IS CLASS DOJO?

We use <u>Class Dojo</u> to recognize positive student behavior. Students can earn 1 point for attending a class, 1 point each for being ready, responsible, and respectful, and up to 2 gold star points for going above and beyond. Class Dojo allows teachers and parents to easily communicate through the messenger that translates into 60 different languages. We also post information and updates for what is happening around Rowland. Ask your student's teacher for a code to sign up.

Students have been earning points through class dojo which allows them to earn rewards. Students earn certificates for achieving 100 and 200 point levels. (POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS AND SUPPORTS)

The goal of PBIS is to support students' academic and behavioral outcomes by using universal language and expectations, consistent behavioral teaching practices, and consistent behavioral response guidelines and data to make decisions. Students have a clearer understanding of what is expected, and are acknowledged for expected behaviors.
