Flexible Instructional Day [FID]

On a Flexible Instruction Day (FID), students will complete assignments at home, virtually, via logging into their Google Classroom or on packets provided from school. *[May be used if the school closure is due to inclement weather, in place of a snow day].*

- ✚ All students will receive communication about the Flexible Instruction Day (FID) through their assigned classes within their Google Classroom. This communication will describe how to access instructional material, how to log attendance and how to request assistance for the day.
- ✚ Assignments and activities will be made available to students by 8:30 A.M. on the morning of the FID. Upon logging in, student's participation will be electronically documented.
- ✚ Students will be considered present for the FID upon verification of login status in the LMS, Google Classroom, or work completion.
- ✚ Students will have five (5) school days to complete FID activities to full credit for grading purposes.

Emergency Closure

On an Emergency Closure Day, students will not attend virtual teaching sessions and will not complete assignments from home. *[This model may be used if there is an unanticipated need to close the school].*

- ✚ There will be no school Online or in-person.
- ✚ Make up days will be announced.

Remote Instructional Day

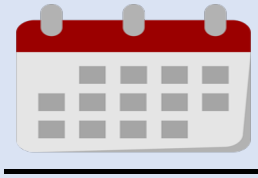
On a Remote Instructional Day model, students will attend remote instruction from home via logging into a Zoom through their Google Classroom. Students will follow their regular daily schedule. *[May be used if there is a closure due to the need to quarantine].*

- ✚ Zoom meetings will follow the same schedule as in-person instruction.
- ✚ All students will receive communication about the Remote Instructional Day through their Class/Morning Meeting, Advisory or Mentoring class. This communication will describe how to access instructional material, how to attend classes and how to request assistance for the day.
- ✚ Attendance will be verified by attendance in live virtual sessions. For more information, please contact your child(ren)'s teacher.

Asynchronous Remote Learning Day

On an Asynchronous Remote Learning Day, students will login into their Class Meeting, or the Advisory/Mentoring Period at the same time as the in-person day begins. The teacher will review the expectations for the child to work independently through the assignments on Google Classroom for the day. *[May be used if there is a closure due to the need to quarantine, staff shortage or testing days].*

- ✚ Teachers may conduct meetings with individual or small groups of students, conduct parent conferences, or attend planned office house.

May be used if there is a closure due to the need to quarantine.

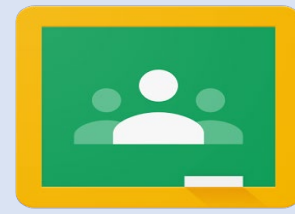
On a Remote Instructional Day model, students will attend remote instruction from home via logging into a Zoom through their Google Classroom. Students will follow their regular daily schedule.
